

# Cookie Policy pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR)

This policy describes the use of cookies and similar technologies by **2025 MG S.R.L.** (hereinafter referred to as “**MG S.R.L.**” or the “**Controller**”) on the website [www.mg-eng.com](http://www.mg-eng.com).

## 2. What are cookies

Cookies are small text files that websites send to the user’s device, where they are stored and later sent back to the same sites upon the next visit. They allow the storage of information about the user’s preferences, improve browsing, and offer additional functionalities.

## 3. Types of cookies used

This website may use the following categories of cookies:

- **Technical and necessary cookies:** essential for the proper functioning of the site. These do not require user consent.
- **Functionality cookies:** allow the site to remember user preferences (e.g., language).
- **Analytics/statistics cookies:** used to collect aggregated and anonymous information about website usage, for example via external services such as Google Analytics (subject to consent).
- **Third-party cookies:** generated by embedded services (e.g., maps, videos, social plugins). These third parties may collect data beyond our control.

## 4. Purpose and legal basis of processing

Cookies are processed for the following purposes:

- Ensuring the technical functionality of the website (legal basis: **legitimate interest**)
- Analyzing traffic and improving the services offered (legal basis: **consent**)
- Managing external content and services (legal basis: **consent**).

## 5. Consent management

When first accessing the site, a banner is displayed for cookie management. The user can:

- Accept all cookies
- Reject non-essential cookies

- Customize preferences

Consent can be modified at any time via the banner (if available) or through browser settings.

## 6. Managing cookies via browser

Users can also disable or delete cookies through their browser settings:

- Chrome
- Firefox
- Edge
- Safari

## 7. Data recipients and disclosures

Data collected through cookies may be shared with external service providers acting as data processors (Article 28 GDPR), such as hosting providers, analytics services, or content platforms.

## 8. Extra-EU data transfers

The website is built on the **Wix** platform, which may involve data transfers to non-EU countries. Wix declares that it ensures an adequate level of protection through **European Commission adequacy decisions** or **Standard Contractual Clauses**.

## 9. Data retention

Cookies have variable durations depending on their type. Technical cookies are stored for the session duration or for strictly necessary periods. Analytics and profiling cookies are retained as specified in the respective third-party provider policies.

## 10. Data subject rights

Users may exercise their rights under Articles 15 et seq. of the GDPR, including:

- Access to personal data
- Rectification or erasure
- Restriction or objection to processing
- Data portability
- Complaint to the Data Protection Authority
